4. Complete job analyses to produce functional job descriptions on a routine basis
5. Complete clinical documentation and timekeeping via a web-based EMR system

7. Collaborate with an Occupational Health Nurse, Environmental Health & Safety Engineer, and other key workplace contacts to develop wellness initiatives
8. Provide regular employee education via newsletters, group presentations, and individual consultation
